



Structured Workplace Learning

The Structured Workplace Learning program is designed to provide an initial link between schools and host employers. A major element of our role is to source opportunities for both **Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) Placements** and **School Based Apprenticeships or Traineeships (SBATs)** with employers from a broad range of industries.

SWL Placements are for students undertaking a VET (Vocational Education and Training) Certificate as part of their VCE or VCAL. Students require workplace based hours undertaking structured, supervised and relevant tasks in a specific environment.

SBATs are for students who wish to combine senior secondary studies (VCE or VCAL), part time work and structured training with a registered training organisation (RTO) which leads to attainment of a nationally recognised VET qualification.

The BGKLEN facilitates these placements by working with schools and employers in our region. Placement opportunities are uploaded onto the SWL Portal so students can search for their own placements

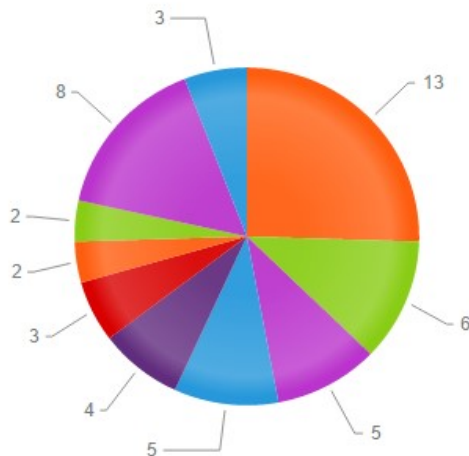
