Develop an understanding and awareness of Occupational Health and Safety to be safe in the workplace.

Overview

The Stay Safe OH&S Workshops explore the elements that make up ensuring a workplace is safe through a range of videos, discussion, and activities. Videos and a OH&S Booklet have been developed by BGKLLEN for students to gain further insight into the processes involved in OH&S, as well as, activities to apply their understanding of OH&S to real work environments.

Workshop 1 develops students' understanding of:

- Duty of Care and the role and responsibility of HSR's
- The OH&S Acts, Regulations and Safety Regulators
- Hazards and risk management

Workshop 2 builds on workshop 1 and guides students to carry out their own risk assessments.
