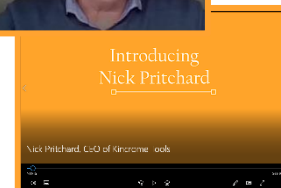
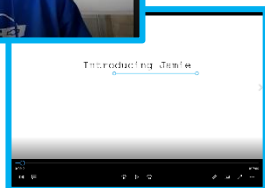


Career Journey – Mini Video Series
